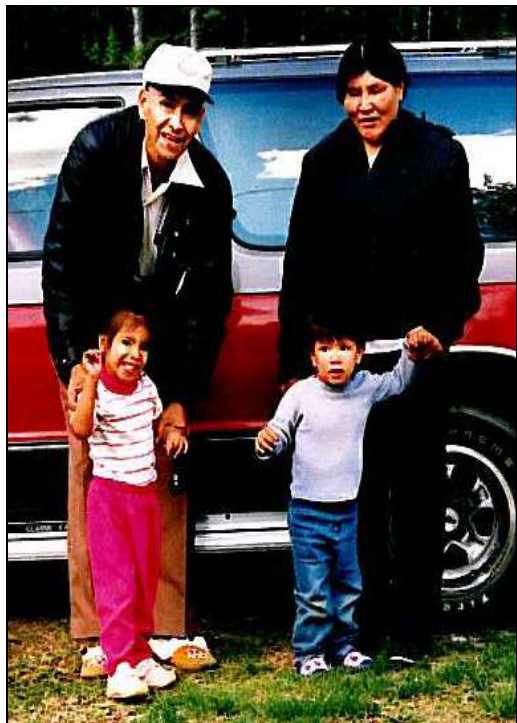


# MISSING
